Declaration of an Unlawful Society ("Sawaba" Party or Parti Sawaba) Order 1965

Commencement: 29th July 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 62 of the Criminal Code, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order—

1. The Society commonly known as the "Sawaba Party" or alternatively Parti Sawaba is hereby declared to be a society dangerous to the good government of Nigeria.

Declaration of Unlawful Society.

2. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of an unlawful Society ("Sawaba" Party or Parti Sawaba) Order 1965 and shall apply throughout the Federation except Northern Nigeria.

Citation and application.

MADE at Lagos this 29th day of July 1965.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order is made under section 62 of the Criminal Code Act which does not apply to Northern Nigeria where the power to declare an organisation an unlawful society is contained in section 97A of the Penal Code. Accordingly an Order is being made there simultaneously in respect of the Sawaba Party otherwise known as Parti Sawaba.
