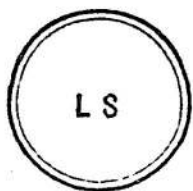

### CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

By His Excellency Doctor NWAFOR ORIZU, Acting President and Commander-in-Chief of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.



NWAFOR ORIZU

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 111 of the Constitution of the Federation it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court shall be:—(a) The Chief Justice of Nigeria; (b) any such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by Parliament.

AND WHEREAS the number of Justices of the Supreme Court is now seven in addition to the Chief Justice of Nigeria.

AND WHEREAS by subsection (4) of section 112 of the said Constitution of the Federation, it is further provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant the President may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court.

NOW THEREFORE, I, NWAFOR ORIZU, Acting President and Commander-in-Chief of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, do hereby, appoint SIR VAHE BAIRAMIAN to act in the Office of a Justice of the Supreme Court as from the 30th day of November, 1965.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federal Republic of Nigeria at State House, Lagos, this 11th day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.
