Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 1) Order 1966

Commencement 27th March 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Customs Tariff Act 1965 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council hereby makes the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 1) Order 1966 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

Short title and extent.

2. Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of the Customs Tariff Act 1964 as the same was replaced by the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 3) Order 1965 are hereby amended as indicated in the Schedule appended to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Order has the following effects -

- 1. It increases the rates of duty on various categories of cigarettes by 5 per centum.
- 2. It relaxes the restriction on the unit of output and sale of matches by making it possible for proportionate excise duties to be charged on boxes and booklets containing less than 80 matches.
- 3. It increases the concessionary rate of duty on gas and diesel oil from 4d to 8d per gallon.
 - 4. It reduces the duty on paints from 2d to 1d per pound.
- 5. It imposes an excise duty of 5 per centum of the selling price on radio-grams and record players.
