THE STATE SECURITY (DETENTION OF PERSONS) DECREE 1966 (1966 No. 3)

The State Security (Detention of Persons) Order 1966

Commencement: 20th September 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 (g) of the State Security (Detention of Persons) Decree 1966 (as amended by the State Security (Detention of Persons) (Amendment) Decree 1966) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government, Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces, hereby makes the following Order—

1. The persons specified in the Schedule to this Order, being persons detained under the State Security (Detention of Persons) (No. 4) Decree 1966, shall continue to be so detained for a period not exceeding six months with effect from the 20th of September 1966.

Continuation of detention. 1966 No. 18.

- 2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the State Security (Detention of Persons) Order 1966 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 20th September 1966.
