THE STATE SECURITY (DETENTION OF PERSONS) DECREE 1966

(1966 No. 3)

The State Security (Detention of Persons) Order 1967

Commencement: 11th March 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 (g) of the State Security (Detention of Persons) Decree 1966 as inserted by section 1 of the State Security (Detention of Persons) (Amendment) Decree 1966 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government, hereby makes the following order:—

1. James Walter Emembolu being the person detained under State Security (Detention of Persons) (No. 11) Decree 1966 shall continue to be so detained for a further period of six months with effect from 11th March 1967.

Continuation of detention 1966 No. 64.

- 2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the State Security (Detention of Persons) Order 1967.
- Citation, commencement and application.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 11th March 1967 and shall apply throughout Nigeria.
