CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ACT (CAP. 43)

Trial by Jury (Lagos) (Amendment) Order 1967

Commencement: 24th May 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 335 of the Criminal Procedure Act as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. The trial by Jury (Lagos) Order shall be read and construed as if references therein to rape in any trial with a jury had been omitted, and accordingly the Order aforesaid shall be amended—
 - (a) in section 2 by omitting the words "or with the offence of rape"; and
- (b) in section 3 by omitting the words "or the offence of rape"; and references in the margin of the Order to any such offence shall consequentially be deleted.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Trial by Jury (Lagos) (Amendment) Order 1967 and shall apply to the Federal territory.
