In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Customs Tariff Act 1965, as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council has made the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 3) Order 1967 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
 - (2) This Order shall come into operation on 20th October 1967.
- 2. Schedules 1 and 2 of the Customs Tariff Act 1965 No. 3 as the same was replaced by the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 2) Order 1965 is hereby amended as indicated in the Schedule appended to this Order.

 - (b) by the insertion of the following new item:
 "18B. Roofing sheets, galvanised, of iron, steel or aluminium
 ...ad valorem 5 per centum".
- 3. Schedule 2 of the Excise Act 1965 is hereby amended—by the deletion of Item 4 and the substitution therefor of the following:
 - "4. Goods for the official or personal use of:-
 - (1) The Head of State of the Federal Republic of Nigeria;
 - (2) any person for the time being acting as the Head of State of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, during such period of time as he is so acting".
