## Imports Prohibition (Amendment) Order 1968

*Commencement : 1st June 1968*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 22 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Imports Prohibition (Amendment) Order 1968 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

2. The First Schedule of the Imports Prohibition Order 1959 (which relates to goods absolutely prohibited from being imported) is hereby amended by the deletion of Paragraphs 4A, 7A and 18A.
