THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :---

1. The total of the amounts mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Decree 1966 (which together, but subject to subsection (3) of that section, provide for the issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the year which ended on 31st March 1967, of sums not exceeding in the aggregate seventy-six million, seven hundred and twenty thousand and forty pounds the total of the amounts there mentioned being thereafter pursuant to the Supplementary Appropriation (1966-67) Decree 1967 increased by one million five hundred and eighty-six thousand, eight hundred and twelve pounds), shall be further increased by one hundred and seventy-seven thousand two hundred and sixty-five pounds; and the amount by which the appropriation is so further increased shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Decree.

2. This Decree may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1966-67) Decree 1969 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

THE POST OFFICE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1969



Decree No. 14

[12th March 1969]

Commencement.

1.—(1) On the commencement of this Decree the Ministry shall be charged with responsibility for staff gradings in the department, and appointments to or within the department are thereafter to be made after consultation in that respect with the Ministry.

(2) Accordingly subsection (2) of section 11 of the Post Office (Miscellaneous Provisions) Decree 1966 shall be amended by omitting from paragraph (a) thereof the words "of Establishments".

2.—(1). This Decree may be cited as the Post Office (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1969.
