## **Exemption of Certain Classes of Insurance Business** Order 1969

Commencement: 1st October 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (4) of the National Insurance Corporation of Nigeria Decree 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The following classes of insurance business are hereby exempted from the provisions of section 8 (1) of the National Insurance Corporation of Nigeria Decree 1969, that is to say—
  - (a) life insurance business;
  - (b) fire insurance business;
  - (c) marine insurance business.
- 2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Exemption of Certain Classes of Insurance Business Order 1969 and shall come into force on 1st October 1969.
  - (2) This Order shall apply throughout the Federation.

MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) ACT (CAP. 126)

Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Exemption) Declaration 1969

Commencement: 1st April 1968

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 (d) and (e) of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act, the Constitution (Miscellaneous Provisions) (No. 2) Decree 1967, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government hereby makes the following declaration:

Exemption of Agency and its vehicles from third party insurance requirements.

- 1. The Interim Common Services Agency or any motor vehicles owned by it are hereby declared to be exempted from the provisions of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act.
- Citation, commencement and application.

  2.—(1) This declaration may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Exemption) Declaration 1969 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April 1968.
  - (2) This Declaration shall apply throughout the Federation.
