**The Constitution (Designation of Produce)  
(Amendment) Order 1969**

*Commencement : 20th September 1968*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 165 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government has made the following Order :—
