

**PRODUCE (ENFORCEMENT OF EXPORT STANDARDS)
(AMENDMENT) DECREE 1969**



Decree No. 48

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. In the Produce (Enforcement of Export Standards) Act 1959 and—

(a) for subsection (2) of section 4 (as replaced by the operation of the Adaptation of Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order 1965) there shall be substituted the following new subsection—

“(2) The Board shall be appointed by the Federal Commissioner for Trade and shall consist of a chairman and thirteen other members, all being persons of integrity serving in the public service of the Federation or a State of the Federation and having technical experience of the inspection of produce for export. The chairman and one member shall be in the public service controlled by the Federal Public Service Commission and of the other members one shall be nominated by the Military Governor or the Administrator, as the case may be, of each of the States of the Federation. All appointments to the Board shall be made with the consent of the appropriate public service commission.”;

(b) in the Second Schedule (as amended by the aforesaid Order of 1965) and—

(i) in item 2 (2) there shall be substituted for the word “three” the word “four”, and

(ii) in item 2 (6) for all words therein after the words “chairman, and” there shall be substituted the words “six other members shall be a quorum.”

2.—(1) This Decree may be cited as the Produce (Enforcement of Export Standards) (Amendment) Decree 1969 and shall be read as one with the Produce (Enforcement of Standards) Act 1959 and have the like effect; and that Act and this Decree may be cited together as the Produce (Enforcement of Export Standards) Acts 1959 to 1969.

(2) The Adaptation of Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order 1965 is hereby revoked to the extent necessary to give effect to this Decree.
