LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT 1962 (1962 No. 33)

The Legal Practitioners (Disciplinary Tribunal) (Amendment) **Rules 1970**

Commencement: 27th January 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Legal Practitioners Act 1962 and, of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following rules:—

1. Immediately after rule 16 of the Legal Practitioners (Disciplinary Tribunal) Rules 1963, there shall be inserted the following new rule—

"Findings etc. in cases not amounting conduct.

16A. The tribunal may, if it finds proved misconduct not amounting to infamous conduct in a professional capacity, make such order as the circumstances may require, not inconsistent to infamous with the provisions of the Act."

2. These rules may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Disciplinary Tribunal) (Amendment) Rules 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
