CONSTITUTION OF THE WESTERN STATE (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1970



Decree No. 10

[23rd November 1969]

Commence-
ment.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1.—(1) In subsection (3) of section 49 of the Constitution of the Western State, the words “of the Justices of Appeal of the Court of Appeal of the State or” shall be inserted immediately after the words “such one”.

(2) In subsection (6) of section 52 of the said Constitution, for the words “such one of the Justices of Appeal” there shall be substituted the words “such person, being the Chief Justice of the High Court of the State or one of the Justices of Appeal,”.

2.—(1) This Decree may be cited as the Constitution of the Western State (Amendment) Decree 1970 and shall apply to the Western State.

(2) This Decree shall be deemed to have come into force on 23rd November 1969.
