## PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES (WAR SERVICE) DECREE 1969

(1969 No. 49)

## Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) (Delegation of Powers)

Order 1970

*Commencement : 5th March 1970*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 11 (1) of the Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) Decree 1969 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Major-General Yakubu Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria hereby make the following Order :—

1.—(1) The powers of the Head of the Federal Military Government under the provisions of the Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) Decree 1969 specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order which are described for convenience of reference only in the second column are hereby delegated to the officers respectively mentioned opposite thereto in the third column of the Schedule.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Head of the Federal Military Government from exercising any of the powers hereby delegated.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) (Delegation of Powers) Order 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

## SCHEDULE

The powers under the provisions of the Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) Decree 1969 referred to—

<i>Provisions</i>	<i>Powers Delegated</i>	<i>Officers to whom delegated</i>
Section 3 ..	To grant gratuities to servicemen ..	Federal Commissioner for Establishments.
Section 4 (1)	To grant pension and gratuities in respect of disablement due to war service	Chairman, Pensions Assessment Board.
Section 5 ..	To grant extra pension to seriously disabled servicemen	Chairman, Pensions Assessment Board.
Section 9 ..	To withhold or forfeit pension or gratuity where serviceman is imprisoned	Commander of the Branch of the Armed Forces if serviceman is imprisoned by a Court Martial.
Section 10 ..	To authorise deduction from a serviceman's pension or gratuity where the serviceman is indebted to the Federal Military Government or where the serviceman has, in respect of his pension or gratuity, been overpaid.	Federal Commissioner for Establishments.

**PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES (WAR SERVICE) DECREE 1969**

**Pensions and Gratuities (Pensions Assessment Board) Notice 1970**

*Commencement : 5th March 1970*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule to the Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) Decree 1969 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Major-General Yakubu Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, for the purposes of the said Pensions and Gratuities (War Service) Decree 1969, hereby establish a Pensions Assessment Board which shall consist of the following officers :—

- (a) the Deputy Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Establishments, who shall be Chairman ;
- (b) the Principal Medical Officer, Federal Ministry of Health ; and
- (c) a representative of the authorities of the service concerned.

**BANKING DECREE 1969**  
(1969 No. 1)

**Banking Decree (Nigeria Housing Development  
Society Limited) (Exemption) Order 1970**

*Commencement : 7th February 1969*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 38 (2) of the Banking Decree 1969 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order :—

1. The Nigeria Housing Development Society Limited (otherwise known as the Nigeria Building Society) is hereby exempted from the provisions of the Banking Decree 1969; and accordingly, in section 38 (1) of that Decree immediately after paragraph (d), there shall be inserted a new paragraph as follows—

“(e) the Nigeria Housing Development Society Limited.”

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Banking Decree (Nigeria Housing Development Society Limited) (Exemption) Order 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on 7th February 1969.
