

THE TRADE UNIONS (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1970



Decree No. 27

[29th April 1970]

Commence-
ment.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1.—(1) In section 3 of the principal Act (which excludes the application of that Act to any combination of persons employed in certain establishments) immediately after the words "Civil Aviation Fire and Guard Service" there shall be inserted the words "or in the Customs Preventive Service or in any other service of the Federal or State Government authorised to bear arms".

Amendment
of Cap. 200.

(2) As from the date of commencement of this Decree, the registered trade union named in the Schedule to this Decree shall cease to exist and is hereby dissolved, and the Registrar shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section 18 of the principal Act, cancel the certificate issued by him in respect of the said trade union.

(3) In this Decree, the words "registered", "Registrar" and "trade union" shall bear the meanings assigned to them, respectively, in the Trade Unions Act; and the reference to the principal Act is a reference to the Trade Unions Act.

2. This Decree may be cited as the Trade Unions (Amendment) Decree 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
