Open General Import Licence (Roumania) Notice 1970

Commencement: 20th April 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 3 (4) of the Imports Prohibition Order (No. 2) 1970, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Import Licensing Authority, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. Schedule 1 to the Open General Import Licence (All Countries) Notice 1970 (which specifies the countries excepted from the provisions of section 1 of that Notice) is hereby amended by the deletion of the entry relating to Roumania.

Deletion of Roumania from Schedule 1 of L.N. 42 of 1970.

2.—(1) This Notice may be cited as the Open General Import Licence (Roumania) Notice 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

Citation, extent and commencement.

(2) This Notice shall be deemed to have come into operation on 20th April 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Notice but is intended to explain its effect)

This Notice permits the importation from Roumania of all goods other than those set out in Schedule 2 to the Open General Import Licence (All Countries) Notice 1970 (L.N. 42 of 1970). Accordingly, in respect of goods which are so permitted it is not necessary for importers to obtain specific import licences.
