In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 (2) of the Import Prohibition (No. 2) Order 1970, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Import Licensing Authority hereby give notice as follows:—

- 1. The Open General Import Licence (All Countries) No. 1 of 1970 is hereby amended in Part A of Schedule 2—
 - (a) by omitting the entries under item 8;
 - (b) in item 51 in the description column by substituting for the word "mistered"; and in the column 'Item No.', by substituting the number "90" for the number "00";
 - (c) in item 190 and in the column 'Item No.', by substituting the number "22" for the number "29": and
 - (d) by the addition at the end of the said Part A of the new entries set out in the Schedule to this Notice.
- 2. The Open General Import Licence (All Countries) No. 2 of 1969 (Amendment) Notice 1970 is hereby revoked.

Amendment of Schedule 2 to L.N. 42 of 1970.

3.—(1) This notice may be cited as the Open General Import Licence (All Countries) No. 1 of 1970 (Amendment) Notice 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the above Notice, but is intended to explain its purpose)

This Notice amends Part A of Schedule 2 of the Open General Import Licence (All Countries) No. 1 of 1970 by adding thereto some other goods in respect of which, before importation into Nigeria, importers are required to obtain specific import licence. It also excludes butter from Part A of the said Schedule 2 and makes other minor corrections thereto.

OIL TERMINAL DUES DECREE 1969 (1969 No. 9)

Oil Terminals (Application of Ports Act, etc.) Regulations 1970

Commencement: 1st January 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Oil Terminal Dues Decree 1969, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Application of s.82 of Ports Act to oil terminals. Cap. 155. 1. Subject to the provisions of this regulation, section 82 of the Ports Act (which relates to the power of the Authority to make regulations for the levy of dues and rates) shall, with all necessary modifications and omissions, apply in relation to oil terminals as it applies in relation to ports under the Ports Act.

Extension of Regulations for levy of dues and rates to oil terminals, 1969 No. 9. 2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, the regulations made by the Nigerian Ports Authority under section 82 of the Ports Act (which prescribe the amount of dues and rates for services rendered by the Authority) are hereby extended in their application, for the purposes of the levy of oil terminal dues, to every oil terminal under the Oil Terminal Dues Decree. 1969 and shall have effect with all necessary modifications and omissions and to the extent not inconsistent with the provisions of the said Decree.

L. of N. 1958, Volume IX page 1811. (2) Accordingly, but without prejudice to the generality of paragraph (1) of this regulation, terminal dues shall be paid on all oil at the rates specified in paragraph (5) of Part III of the First Schedule to the Nigerian Ports Authority (Dues and Rates) Regulations, as amended from time to time, and on the conditions specified in that Schedule.

Citation, extent, commencement and interpretation.

- 3.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Oil Terminals (Application of Ports Act, etc.) Regulations 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January 1965.
- (3) In these regulations "oil terminal" has the meaning ascribed to it by section 7 of the Oil Terminal Dues Decree 1969.
