## NATIONAL INSURANCE CORPORATION OF NIGERIA DECREE 1969 (1969 No. 22)

## Exemption of Certain Classes of Insurance Business Order 1970

Commencement: 2nd January 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (4) of the National Insurance Corporation of Nigeria Decree 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. The following classes of Insurance Business are hereby exempted from the provisions of section 8 (1) of the National Insurance Corporation of Nigeria Decree 1969, that is to say:—
  - (a) life insurance business;
  - (b) marine insurance business.
- 2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Exemption of Certain Classes of Insurance Business Order 1970 and shall come into force on 2nd January 1971.
  - (2) This Order shall apply throughout the Federation.
- (3) The Exemption of Certain Classes of Insurance Business Order 1969 is hereby revoked.
