Trade Dispute Emergency Decrees (Extension) Order 1970

Commencement: 10th December 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The operation of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) Decree 1968 and the operation of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969 are hereby extended until 11th December 1971.

Extension of operation of 1968 No. 21 and 1969 No. 53.

2. This Order may be cited as the Trade Dispute Emergency Decrees (Extension) Order 1970 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

IMMIGRATION ACT 1963 (1963 No. 6)

John Allen Zanor Deportation Order 1970

Commencement: 28th. November 1970

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of opinion that John Allen Zanor at present in Nigeria ought to be classed as a prohibited immigrant and acting under the power conferred upon me by section 18 (3) of the Immigration Act 1963 hereby order the said John Allen Zanor to be deported from Nigeria as a prohibited immigrant by the first available means and I direct that the said John Allen Zanor shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This Order may be cited as the John Allen Zanor Deportation Order 1970.
