STATE SECURITY (DETENTION OF PERSONS) (REVOCATION) DECREE 1971



Decree No. 1

[18th January 1971]

Commence-

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. The period of detention provided for by the State Security (Detention of Persons) (No. 14) Decree 1966 shall be deemed to have been extended from 4th June 1967 to 25th January 1971, and on the said 25th January 1971 the detention of the persons specified in the Schedule to this Decree (being the persons detained under the said Decree of 1966) shall be revoked.

Extension and revocation of detention. 1966 No. 77.

2.—(1) On 26th January 1971 the State Security (Detention of Persons) (No. 14) Decree 1966 shall stand repealed.

Repeal.

(2) For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared that section 6 of the Interpretation Act 1964 (which, among other things, provides that the repeal of an enactment shall not affect the previous operation of the enactment or anything duly done thereunder) applies in respect of the repeal effected by subsection (1) above.

3. This Decree may be cited as the State Security (Detention of Persons) (Revocation) Decree 1971 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
