IMMIGRATION ACT 1963

Sagno Revo Deportation Order 1971

WHEREAS on 28th December 1970, before the Magistrate's Court of Lagos, Sagno Revo was charged with and convicted of an offence contrary to section 17 (1) (f) (i) of the Immigration Act 1963 :

AND WHEREAS the said Court in exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 (1) of the said Act has referred the facts of the case of the said SAGNO REVO to me and made recommendation for his deportation :

AND WHEREAS I, Kam Selem, Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, have considered the continuing position of the said Sagno Revo in Nigeria and have deemed it fit to make a deportation Order :

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 18 (3) of the Immigration Act 1963, I hereby order that the said SAGNO REVO, a prohibited immigrant, shall be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and I direct that he shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.
