

## MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS (AMENDMENTS) DECREE 1971



## Decree No. 45

[17th September 1971]

Commence-  
ment.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :—

1.—(1) The provision in any of the enactments specified in the Schedule hereto, which permits the making of rules by the Chief Justice of Nigeria as to the selection of members of a disciplinary tribunal for the purpose of the proceedings of such tribunal, shall no longer apply.

(2) Accordingly, the words—

“as to the selection of members of a tribunal for the purpose of any proceedings and”

in the provision mentioned in column 2 opposite the enactment in column 1 of the said Schedule are hereby repealed.

2. This Decree may be cited as the Miscellaneous Provisions (Amendments) Decree 1971 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
