Trade Disputes Emergency Decrees (Extension) Order 1971

Commencement: 11th December 1971

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The operation of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) Decree 1968 and the operation of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969 are hereby extended for a period of six months commencing on 12th December 1971.

Extension of operation of 1968 No. 21 and 1969 No. 53.

2. This Order may be cited as the Trade Disputes Emergency Decrees (Extension) Order 1971 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
