PENSIONS ACT (Cap. 147)

Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) Order 1972

Commencement : 16th February 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 2 of the Pensions Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Federal Commissioner for Establishments, hereby make the following Order :---

1.—(1) The offices mentioned in the Schedule hereto (which are additional to the offices already declared pensionable by the Orders mentioned in subsection (2) of this section) are hereby declared to be pensionable offices within the meaning of section 2 of the Pensions Act with effect from the dates specified in the said Schedule.

(2) The following are the Orders referred to in subsection (1) above—

(a) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) Order 1954;

(b) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) (Amendment) Order 1955;

(c) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) (Amendment) Order 1956;

(d) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) (Amendment) Order 1957;

(e) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) (Amendment) Order 1959;

(f) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) (Amendment) Order 1960;

(g) the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) Order 1969.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pensions (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) Order 1972 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
