LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT 1962
(1962 No. 33)

**Legal Practitioners (Certain Concessions)
Regulations 1972**

Commencement : 6th March 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Legal Education by section 2B (2) of the Legal Practitioners Act 1962 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Council hereby makes the following regulations :—

1.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below, section 2B (1) (b) of the Legal Practitioners Act 1962 (which provides that a person shall not be called to the Bar unless he produces a qualifying certificate to the Benchers) shall not apply to any person entitled to practise as a barrister and solicitor by virtue of section 2 (4) of that Act if that person has been so entitled for a period of at least three years preceding his application for enrolment.

(2) A person shall not be entitled to the benefit of paragraph (1) above for the purposes of an application for enrolment if the application is made after the 30th day of June 1972.

(3) A person exempted under this regulation shall be issued with a certificate to that effect by the Council and shall, after being called to the Bar pursuant to the provisions of the Act aforesaid, be enrolled by the Registrar accordingly.

(4) In this regulation—

“the Council” means the Council of Legal Education ;

“enroll” means to enter a person’s name in the roll maintained in pursuance of section 18 (1) of the Legal Practitioners Act 1962, and cognate expressions shall be construed accordingly.

2.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Certain Concessions) Regulations 1972 and shall apply throughout the Federation.

Citation, etc.

(2) The Legal Practitioners (Qualifications) Regulations 1963 which have become spent shall cease to have effect.
