CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1958
(1958 No. 55)

Brewing (Amendment) Regulations 1972

Commencement : 27th June 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Shehu Shagari, the Federal Commissioner for Finance hereby make the following regulations :—

1. The Brewing Regulations 1959 are hereby amended as follows :—

(a) in regulation 5—

(i) after paragraph (vi) thereof there shall be added the following new paragraph (vii), that is—

“(vii) enter separately in the book in the appropriate column the quantity of water he intends to add to the brewed wort at any stage of the brewing ;”,

(ii) the existing paragraph (vii) shall be renumbered as paragraph “(viii)” ;

(b) in regulation 12 (6) for the word “collecting” there shall be substituted the word “storage”.

The Regulations make sundry amendments to the Brewing Regulations 1959 and enable the Board of Customs and Excise to maintain a stricter control over certain operations of beer breweries.
