### Dominic Joseph Moss Prohibited Immigrant Order 1973

Commencement: 3rd March 1973

I, the Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of opinion that the admission of DOMINIC JOSEPH Moss into Nigeria would be contrary to the interest of national security and acting under the powers conferred upon me by section 17 (1) (d) of the Immigration Act 1963 the said DOMINIC JOSEPH Moss shall be deemed to be a prohibited immigrant and shall be refused admission into Nigeria and I hereby order accordingly.

This Order may be cited as the DOMINIC JOSEPH Moss Prohibited Immigrant Order 1973.
