EXPORT OF NIGERIAN PRODUCE (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1973



Decree No. 45

[6th December 1973]

Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. Section 1 of the Export of Nigerian Produce (Special Provisions) Decree 1968 (which, amongst other things, deals with the powers of the Federal Commissioner for Trade) is hereby amended as follows—

Amendment of section 1 (1) (4) 1968 No. 14.

- "(a) in subsection (1) thereof, immediately after the word "Trade" the words "and Industries" are hereby repealed;
- (b) in subsection (4) thereof, for the words "not more than twelve months" there shall be substituted the words "not less than twelve months nor more than three years".
- 2. This Decree may be cited as the Export of Nigerian Produce (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Decree amends the Export of Nigerian Produce (Special Provisions) Decree 1968 to increase the tenure of office of the Chairman of the Nigerian Produce Marketing Company Limited to 3 years and to provide for the correct designation of the appropriate Commissioner.
