University of Nigeria (Provisional Council) Order 1973

Commencement : 17th December 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 (2) of the University of Nigeria (Transitional Provisions) Decree 1973 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government hereby makes the following Order :—

1.—(1) The Provisional Council of the University of Nigeria established by section 2 (1) of the University of Nigeria (Transitional Provisions) Decree 1973 shall consist of the persons specified in the Schedule hereunder.

(2) Each member shall hold office for such period and on such terms and conditions (including remuneration or allowances) as may be directed by the Head of the Federal Military Government.

2. This Order may be cited as the University of Nigeria (Provisional Council) Order 1973.
