Civil Aviation (Appointment of Inspectors of Accidents) Notice 1974

Commencement : 2nd February 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 7 (1) of the Civil Aviation (Investigation of Accidents) Regulations 1965, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Federal Commissioner for Transport hereby gives the following Notice :—

1. The persons mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Notice are hereby appointed as Chief Inspector of Accidents and Inspectors of accidents respectively (all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "inspectors") with effect from 2nd February 1973.

Appointment of persons as inspectors of accidents.

2. The inspectors are appointed for the purpose of carrying out investigation into the causes and circumstances of the accident to B707 aircraft operated by the Ethiopian Airlines bearing the Registration Marks ETACD which occurred on the approach to Lagos Airport on 24th January 1973.

Functions of inspectors.

3. Any person who wishes to make representations concerning the causes or the circumstances of the accident may do so in writing within 14 days of the publication of this Notice to—

4. This Notice may be cited as Civil Aviation (Appointment of Inspectors of Accidents) Notice 1974 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on 2nd February 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
