Citation.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

- 1. The Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree 1972 is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (a) in section 16 of the Decree—
  - (i) in subsection (1) thereof the expression "supermarket" and its definition shall be deleted;
  - (ii) for subsection (3) thereof there shall be substituted the following new subsection:—
  - "(3) The references in Schedules 1 and 2 to "Retail trade", "Supermarket", "Departmental Store" and "Wholesale distribution" shall be construed respectively as references to those expressions as may be defined for the purposes of this Decree by an order made by the Commissioner with the approval of the Federal Executive Council.";
  - (b) in Schedule 1 to the Decree-
    - (i) item 10 shall be deleted; and
  - (ii) immediately after item 21, there shall be inserted the following new item:—
  - "21A. Stevedoring and Shore-Handling."; and
  - (c) in Schedule 2 to the Decree, immediately after item 5, there shall be inserted a new item as follows:—
    - "5A. Clearing and forwarding agencies."
- 2. This Decree may be cited as the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1974.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its purpose)

The Decree amends the Schedules to the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree 1972 to transfer "Clearing and forwarding agencies" from Schedule 1 to Schedule 2 and to insert "Stevedoring and Shore-handling" in Schedule 1. It also makes some slight changes in the provisions of the Decree relative to the definition of certain expressions.
