**Companies (Special Provisions) (Exemption) Order 1975**

*Commencement : 17th January 1975*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 (3) of the Companies (Special Provisions) Decree 1973 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Federal Executive Council hereby makes the following order :—

1. The foreign companies listed in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, being companies engaged in the projects specified in the second column of the said Schedule, are hereby exempted from the provisions of Part X of the Companies Decree 1968 for the periods respectively set against each company in the third column of that Schedule.

Exemption from the requirements of Part X of 1968 No. 51.

2. This Order may be cited as the Companies (Special Provisions) (Exemption) Order 1975.
