### CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1958 (1958 No. 55)

#### Importation and Exportation by Land and Inland Waters (Amendment) Regulations 1976

#### Commencement: 17th January 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 (1), 24 (4), 34 (1) and 53 (1) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Asumoh Ete Ekukinam, the Federal Commissioner for Finance, hereby make the following regulations :—

1. For the Schedule to the Importation and Exportation by Land and Inland Waters Regulations 1967, (which Schedule specifies approved routes by land or inland waters for the importation or exportation of goods into or from Nigeria) there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Importation and Exportation City by Land and Inland Waters (Amendment) Regulations 1976.
