THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

(1963 No. 20)

The Statutory Appointments (Commercial Legislation)
(Amendment) Notice 1976

Commencement : 21st October 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 147 of the Constitution of the Federation and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Public Service Commission of the Federation hereby gives notice as follows :—

1. In respect of the statutory appointments to be made by virtue of the enactments set out in column 2 of the Schedule hereunder, the Officers posted to the Commercial Law Division of the Federal Ministry of Trade whose names appear in column 1 of the Schedule, are hereby appointed by the Public Service Commission of the Federation to perform the duties of the offices specified against their respective names in column 3 of the said Schedule.

Appointment of officers to perform certain duties.

2. If an officer mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, then, until another person is appointed to and has assumed those functions, or until that officer has resumed those functions, as the case may be, those functions shall be performed by any other officer mentioned in the said column 1.

Duties to be performed by any other officer in certain cases.

3. The Statutory Appointments (Commercial Legislation) (No. 4) Notice 1971 is hereby revoked.

4. This Notice may be cited as the Statutory Appointments (Commercial Legislation) (Amendment) Notice 1976 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 21st October, 1974.

TREASURY BILLS ACT 1959
(1959 No. 11)

Treasury Bills (Amendment) Regulations 1976

Commencement : 1st November 1975.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 10 of the Treasury Bills Act 1959 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Asumoh Ete Ekukinam, the Federal Commissioner for Finance, after consultation with the Central Bank of Nigeria, hereby make the following regulation:—

1. In regulation 4 (2) of the Treasury Bills Regulations 1960, for references to the chief of banking operations there shall be substituted the words "Chief Accountant".

The Regulation substitutes the Chief Accountant of the Central Bank of Nigeria for the Chief of Banking Operations as a signatory to Treasury Bills.
