POLICE ACT

(CAP 154)

The Nigeria Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976

Commencement: 3rd May 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Police Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government has made the following regulations:—

- 1. The Nigeria Police Regulations 1968 are hereby amended as follows, that is:—
 - (a) in regulation 33, paragraph (e) shall be deleted;
 - (b) in regulation 34, paragraph (i) shall be deleted;
 - (c) in regulation 258, in paragraph (a) thereof, the words "and the L.N. 53 of Special Branch" shall be deleted:
 - (d) regulation 300 shall be deleted.
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Nigeria Police (Amendment) Citation. (No. 2) Regulations 1976.

IMMIGRATION ACT 1963 (1963 No. 6)

S. R. Bathis Deportation Order 1976

Commencement: 24th April 1976

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of the opinion that S. R. Bathis at present in Nigeria ought to be classified as a prohibited immigrant and acting under the powers conferred upon me by section 17 (1) (j) of the Immigration Act 1963 hereby order the said S. R. Bathis to be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and direct that the said S. R. Bathis shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This Order may be cited as the S. R. Bathis Deportation Order 1976.
