THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. The aggregate of the amount mentioned in section 1 of the Appropriation Decree 1975 shall be further increased by fourteen million, nine hundred and fifty-three thousand, eight hundred and fifty naira and this additional amount shall be appropriated to the heads of expenditure specified

## NATIONAL PROVIDENT FUND (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1976



## Decree No. 35

[See section 4] Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :-

- 1.—(1) The National Provident Fund Investment Committee and its Sub-Committee established by section 4 of the National Provident Fund Act 1964 are hereby dissolved.
- (2) Accordingly, the National Provident Fund Act 1964 and the National Provident Fund (Management Board, etc.) Decree 1974 are hereby amended to the extent set out in the Schedule to this Decree.
- 2. The National Provident Fund Management Board established under the National Provident Fund (Management Board, etc.) Decree 1974 shall, in addition to all the functions formerly performed before dissolution by the National Provident Fund Investment Committee and its Sub-Committee, be solely responsible as an autonomous body for the administration and management of the Fund and the Reserve Fund.
- 3. Where a public officer was dismissed, removed or retired compul-Benefits to sorily from his office pursuant to the provisions of the Public officers (Special Provisions) Decree 1976, he shall be entitled to receive age benefits under section 21 of the National Provident Fund Act 1961 notwithstanding that he has not attained the age of fifty-five years; and in case of the death of any. such public officer who leaves any survivors, such survivors shall be entitled to survivors' benefits under section 22 of the said Act.
- 4. This Decree may be cited as the National Provident Fund (Amendment) Decree 1976 and shall be deemed to have come into force—
  - (a) in respect of sections 1 and 2 hereof, on 29th March 1975; and
  - (b) in respect of section 3 hereof, on 29th July 1975.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its purpose)

The Decree amends the National Provident Fund Act 1964 and the National Provident Fund (Management Board, etc.) Decree 1974 to give full powers of management to the Board and to abolish the Investment Committee and its Sub-Committee which before this Decree had been solely responsible for the control of the investment of the Fund.

The Decree also amends the National Provident Fund Act 1961 to waive the limitation of age imposed by section 21 in respect of officers affected by the recent 'clean up' exercise in the Public Services of the Federation and of the States
