CERTAIN JUDICIAL ACTS (VALIDATION) DECREE 1976



Decree No. 60

[30th November 1976]

Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

- 1. Notwithstanding section 52 of the Constitution of former Eastern Nigeria (as modified by the Constitution (Basic Provisions) Decree 1975) and of section 5 of the High Court Law of former Eastern Nigeria as in force in the Rivers State of Nigeria (which provides that any person holding office of a judge of the High Court of the Rivers State shall vacate that office when he attains the age of 62 years), the tenure of office of the person holding office of Chief Justice of the Rivers State on 19th May 1975 shall be deemed have been extended up to and including 20th May 1976 and, accordingly, anything done by the said person, acting in his judicial capacity, at any time on or before that date shall be deemed to have been validly done.
- 2. This Decree may be cited as the Certain Judicial Acts (Validation)
 Decree 1976.
