Erika Hegwig Crompton (Prohibited Immigrant) Order 1976

Commencement: 25th November 1976

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of opinion that the admission

of Erika Hegwig Crompton into Nigeria would be contrary to the interest of national security and is therefore, in accordance with the provisions of section 17 (1) (d) of the Immigration Act 1963, deemed to be a prohibited immigrant, and acting under the powers conferred upon me by section 17 of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, order that the said Erika Hegwig Crompton shall be refused admission into Nigeria accordingly.

This Order may be cited as the Erika Hegwig Crompton (Prohibited Immigrant) Order 1976.
