CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1958

(1958 No. 55)

Import Prohibition (Amendment) Order 1977

Commencement : 3rd January 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Asumoh Ete Ekukinam, Federal Commissioner for Finance, hereby make the following Order :—

1. The Import Prohibition Order 1976 is hereby amended in Schedule 3 Part 1 by the insertion immediately after paragraph 20, of the following new paragraphs :

"21. Eaves-dropping equipment ; probe microphones ; mini-sized dynamic microphones ; contact microphones ; pocket-sized tape-recorders ; lie detectors ; door-step microphones ; pocket wireless transmitting and receiving sets ; pocket electronic stethoscopes ; wireless telephone and space monitoring sets ; micro-cameras ; and all forms of mini-transmitters.
