# IMMIGRATION ACT 1963 (1963 No. 6)

### Walter Westborg Deportation Order 1977

#### Commencement : 19th May 1977

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of the opinion that Walter Westborg at present in Nigeria ought to be classified as a prohibited immigrant and acting under the powers conferred on me by section 18 (3) of the Immigration Act 1963 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, accordingly order that the said Walter Westborg be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and I direct that the said Walter Westborg shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This order may be cited as the Walter Westborg Deportation Order 1977.

## POLICE ACT (CAP 154)

## The Nigeria Police (Amendment) Regulations 1977

#### Commencement : 19th May 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Police Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Head of the Federal Military Government hereby, on the recommendation of the Nigeria Police Council, makes the following regulations :--

1. In regulation 67 (2) of the Nigeria Police Regulations 1968, for the expression "not less than 19" there shall be substituted the expression "not less than 17".

2. These regulations may be cited as the Nigeria Police (Amendment) Citation. Regulations 1977.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

## (This note does not form part of the above Regulations but is intended to explain the purpose)

The Regulations reduce the existing minimum age for enlisting into the Nigeria Police to 17 years.
