## Thomas Noel Abdi Deportation Order 1977

I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, being of the opinion that Thomas Noel Abdi at present in Nigeria ought to be classified as a prohibited immigrant and acting under the powers conferred upon me by section 18 (3) of the Immigration Act 1963, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, accordingly order that the said Thomas Noel Abdi be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and I direct that the said Thomas Noel Abdi shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This Order may be cited as the Thomas Noel Abdi Deportation Order 1977.

#### Mohammed Ammah Deportation Order 1977

Commencement: 9th June 1977

WHEREAS a recommendation by a court of competent jurisdiction for the deportation of Mohammed Ammah is in force;

AND WHEREAS the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs after considering the recommendation aforesaid thinks it fit to make an order for the deportation of the said Mohammed Ammah:

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 20 (1) of the Immigration Act 1963, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Federal Commissioner for Internal Affairs, hereby order the said Mohammed Ammah to be deported from Nigeria by the first available means and direct that the said Mohammed Ammah shall thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

This Order may be cited as the Mohammed Ammah Deportation Order 1977.
