LEGAL AID (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1978

Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

- 1. The Legal Aid Decree 1976 is hereby amended as follows :-
- Amendment of 1976 No. 56.
- (a) for paragraph (e) of section 2(1) thereof, there shall be substituted the following—
 - "(e) two representatives of the Nigerian Bar Association one of whom shall be appointed by the Federal Executive Council and the other shall be the person for the time being holding the office of General Secretary of the Association:";
- (b) in paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 thereof, for the expression "(not being public officers)" there shall be substituted the expression "(not being ex officio members)".
- 2. This Decree may be cited as the Legal Aid (Amendment) Decree 1978.
