Federal Revenue Court (Judicial Divisions) Notice 1979

*Commencement : 1st February 1979*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 (1) of the Federal Revenue Court Decree 1973, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the President of the Federal Revenue Court, hereby give the following notice :—

1. For the purposes of section 19 (1) of the Federal Revenue Court Decree 1973, the whole of the Federation is hereby divided into the Judicial Divisions specified in the Schedule hereunder which Divisions shall be designated as provided in the first column thereof and for the purposes of section 19 (4) of the Decree, the Court shall sit at the places specified in the third and fourth columns of the said Schedule.
