CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1958 (1958 No. 55)

Import Prohibition (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1979

Commencement: 28th November 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 22 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Alex Ekwueme, Federal Minister of Finance, hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. Schedule 3, Part II of the Import Prohibition Order 1979 is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) delete item 8 and substitute therefor the following, that is-
 - "(8) Kraft paper (glazed or unglazed) excluding Kraft paper imported by a manufacturer approved in that behalf by the Minister (Tariff No. 48.01.)";
 - (b) delete item 9 and substitute therefor the following, that is-
 - "(9) Paper board, including liner and corrugated board excluding paper board imported by a manufacturer approved in that behalf by the Minister (Tariff Nos. 48.01 to 48.07).";
 - (c) delete the following items; that is-
 - "(i) 13-Common Salt
 - (ii) 65—Sugar (Cube and granulated)
 - (iii) 77-Razor blade.";
 - (d) re-number items 14 to 82 to read items 13 to 79.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Import Prohibition (Amendment) Citation. (No. 3) Order 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above order but is intended to explain its effects)

The order removes the following commodities from Import Licence viz, common salt, sugar (cube and granulated) and razor blade and also places kraft paper, paper board including liner and corrugated board under Approved User Certificate and thus exempts them from Import Licence.
