

FINANCIAL YEAR ACT 1980



1980 No. 2

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ALTERATION OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR AND FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NEW PERIOD OF JANUARY TO DECEMBER AS BEING THE FINANCIAL YEAR HENCEFORTH AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH.

[1st April 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federation of Nigeria and by authority of same as follows :—

1. As from the commencement of this Act the financial year shall, pursuant to section 277 (1) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1979, be the period of twelve months commencing on 1st January and ending on 31st December :

Provided that with respect to the year 1980 only it shall be the period of 9 months commencing on 1st April and ending on 31st December.

2. Accordingly, for the definition of "financial year" in the Interpretation Act 1964 there shall be substituted the following new definition, that is—

"financial year" means the period of twelve months beginning on 1st January and ending on 31st December, so however that with respect to the year 1980 it shall be the period of nine months beginning on 1st April and ending on 31st December ;”.

3.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Financial Year Act 1980.

(2) This Act shall come into force on 1st April 1980.

POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION (MEMBERSHIP) ACT 1980

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO CONSTITUTE MEMBERSHIP OF THE POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION AS REQUIRED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA.

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and by authority of same as follows :—

1. In pursuance of paragraph 17 of the Third Schedule to the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1979 it is hereby prescribed that the Police Service Commission established thereunder shall consist of 9 members including the Chairman.

ARMY (AMENDMENT) ACT 1980

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE NUMBER OR PERSONS TO CONSTITUTE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ARMY COUNCIL

[2nd April 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federation of Nigeria and by authority of the same as follows :—

1. For subsections (1) and (2) of section 7 of the Nigerian Army Act 1960 as amended by section 1 of the Forces Acts (Amendment) Decree 1976, there shall be substituted the following new subsections, that is—

“(1) The Members of the Army Council shall be—

- (a) the President who shall be the Chairman of the Council ;
- (b) the Minister charged with responsibility for matters relating to defence ;
- (c) the Chief of Defence Staff ;
- (d) the Chief of Army Staff ; and

(2) The Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Defence shall be the Secretary to the Council.

(3) The Council may whenever it deems it necessary, co-opt any officer or any public officer or any person as a member of the Council for the purpose of any particular meeting of the Council but such officer or public officer or person shall have no vote and his membership shall cease at the end of that particular meeting.”

2. This Act may be cited as the Army (Amendment) Act 1980.

Nigeria and by authority of the same as follows :—

1. For section 4 of the Air Force Act 1964, as amended by section
2 of the Forces Acts (Amendment) Decree 1976, there shall be sub-
stituted the following new section :—

4.—(1) The Members of the Air Council shall be—

(a) the President who shall be the Chairman of the
Council ;

(b) the Minister charged with responsibility for matters
relating to Defence ;

(c) the Chief of Defence Staff ;

(d) the Chief of the Air Staff.

(2) The Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Defence
shall be the Secretary to the Council.

(3) The Council may whenever it deems it necessary co-opt
any officer or any public officer or any person as a member of
the Council for the purpose of any particular meeting of the
Council but such officer or public officer or person shall have
no vote and his membership shall cease at the end of the
particular meeting.”

2. This Act may be cited as the Air Force (Amendment) Act 1980.

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO CONSTITUTE MEMBERSHIP OF THE NAVY BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federation of Nigeria and by authority of same as follows :—

1.—(1) For section 4 of the Navy Act 1964, as amended by section 2 of the Forces Acts (Amendment) Decree 1976, there shall be substituted the following new section :—

4.—(1) The members of the Board shall be—

(a) the President who shall be the Chairman of the Board ;

(b) the Minister charged with responsibility for matters relating to Defence ;

(c) the Chief of Defence staff ; and

(d) the Chief of the Naval Staff.

(2) The Permanent Secretary, in the Ministry charged with responsibility for matters relating to Defence shall be Secretary to the Board.

(3) The Board may, whenever it deems it necessary co-opt any officer or any public officer or any person as a member of the Board for the purpose of any particular meeting of the Board ; but such officer or public officer or any person shall have no vote and his membership shall cease at the end of that particular meeting.”

2. This Act may be cited as the Navy (Amendment) Act 1980.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (1979-80) ACT 1980

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND OF THE FEDERATION OF ONE BILLION AND FOUR HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FOUR MILLION NAIRA (₦1,434,000,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE FEDERATION IN RESPECT OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING ON 31ST MARCH 1980 ; AND TO APPROPRIATE THAT SUM FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federation of Nigeria and by authority of same as follows :—

1. The total of the amounts mentioned in section 1 (1) of the Appropriation Decree 1979 and the Supplementary Appropriation (1979-80) Decree 1979 (which together provide for the issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Federation, in respect of the financial year ending on 31st March 1980, of sums not exceeding in the aggregate ten billion, nine hundred and seventy-one million, four hundred and fifty-one thousand and four hundred and thirty naira), shall be increased by one billion and four hundred and thirty-four million naira ; and the additional amount shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Act.
