FEDERAL HIGH COURT ACT 1973

Federal High Court (Judicial Divisions) (Amendment) Notice 1981

Commencement : 1st October 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 (1) of the Federal High Court Act 1973, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, the Chief Judge of the Federal High Court, hereby give the following notice :—

1. For the purposes of section 19 (1) of the Federal High Court Act 1973, the whole of the Federal Republic of Nigeria is hereby divided into the Judicial Divisions specified in the Schedule hereunder which Divisions shall be designated as provided in the first column thereof and for the purposes of section 19 (4) of the Act, the Court shall sit at the places specified in the third and fourth columns of the said Schedule.
