FIRST SCHEDULE

Presiding at meetings.

1. The Chairman of the Authority shall preside at any meeting of the Authority and in his absence the members present shall appoint one of their number to preside at that meeting.

2. The quorum at any meeting of the Authority shall be four.

Validity of proceedings.

3. The proceedings of the Authority shall not be affected by any vacancy in its membership or defect in the appointment of a member or by reason that a person who is not a member has taken part in such proceedings.

- 4.—(1) Where the Authority is desirous to obtain the advice of any person on any particular matter, the Authority may co-opt that person as a member of the Authority for such meeting or meetings as the Authority may decide.
- (2) The person so co-opted shall have all the privileges of a member except that he shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting of the Authority or count towards a quorum.

- 5.—(1) The fixing of the seal of the Authority shall be authenticated by the signature of the Chairman or the Director-General or any member authorized in that behalf by the Authority.
- (2) Any instrument or contract which if made or executed by an individual need not be under seal, may be made or executed on behalf of the Authority by any person generally or specifically authorized in that behalf by the Authority.
- (3) Any document purported to be a document executed under the seal of the Authority shall be received in evidence and shall unless the contrary is proved be presumed to be so executed.
