# National Monument (Old Secretariat Building) (Declaration) Order 1982

Commencement: 6th August 1982

Whereas the National Commission for Museums and Monuments has submitted an application in accordance with section 13 (1) of the National Commission for Museums and Monuments Act 1979 for the declaration as a national monument of the Old Secretariat Building, Marina, Lagos:

AND WHEREAS the application has been considered and duly approved by me:

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 (5) of the aforesaid Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Shehu Usman Aliyu Shagari, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federation, hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Old Secretariat Building further described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a National monument for the purposes of National Commission for Museums and Monuments Act 1979.

2. This Order may be cited as the National Monument (Old Secretariat Building) (Declaration) Order 1982.

### SCHEDULE

Section 1

The building known and referred to as the Old Secretariat Building, and all its appurtenancees access to which is gained via the Marina, Lagos and bounded by the Marina, Brook Street and Broad Street on three sides and by a building on Oil Mill Street.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of this Order but is intended to explain its effect)

The above Order declares the Old Secretariat Building as a National Monument in pursuance of the National Commission for Museums and Monuments Act 1979.
