**Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties)  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1982**

*Commencement : 9th September 1982*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 (1) of the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) Act 1982, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Shehu Usman Aliyu Shagari, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federation, hereby make the following Order :—

1. For paragraph (a) of section 2 of the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties) Order 1982, as amended by the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties) (Amendment) Order 1982, there shall be substituted the following new paragraph :—

“(a) on goods which immediately before the commencement of this Order were either imported free of duty or attracting duty of less than 100%, an additional duty of 5% :

Provided that the foregoing provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to books ;”.

2. This Order may be cited as the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1982.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note does not form part of the above Order but is  
intended to explain its purpose)*

The Order amends the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties) Order 1982, as amended by the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Customs Duties) (Amendment) Order 1982 which, among other things, imposed a 5% customs duty surcharge on all goods erstwhile attracting a duty of 100% or less by exempting books from the imposition of that additional 5% duty in line with Nigeria's international obligations under the UNESCO Convention.

1.—(1) Part II of Schedule 3 to the Finance Act 1981, as amended by the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) Act 1982, the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Import Prohibition) Order 1982 and the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Import Prohibition) (Amendment) Order 1982, is hereby further amended as specified in the following provisions of this Order :—

(a) for item 4 of Part II of Schedule 3 to the Finance Act 1981, as amended by paragraph (a) of Part II of Schedule 3 to the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Import Prohibition) Order 1982, there shall be substituted the following :—

- “4 (a) Prefabricated buildings of wood (including doors and sashes) ;
- (b) fabricated building materials other than glass ;
- (c) all building bricks, other than glass bricks ;
- (d) roofing tiles.

(Tariff Nos. 44.19 to 44.28)” ;

(b) subsection (3) of section 1 of the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Import Prohibition) Order 1982 is hereby consequentially repealed.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note does not form part of the above Order but is intended to explain its purpose)*

The Order amends the various enactments relating to import prohibition and culminating in the Economic Stabilization (Temporary Provisions) (Import Prohibition) Order 1982 (S.I. 6 of 1982) to more specifically define those building materials as are placed under specific import licence.
